



CBA Members Making an Impact



In 2011, Wedbush Bank raised more than \$12,000 to support the financial education and literacy programs at Junior Achievement of Southern California. An Inspiration Bowl was organized, with 100% employee participation (either donating, bowling or both). With the dollars raised, Wedbush Bank employees volunteered their time in 5th grade classrooms teaching "global economics and free enterprise" or spending days at Finance Park educating the high school students and Job Corps young adults on budgeting and finance.

CBA members reported the following contributions for 2011:

- 19,605 community groups were assisted
- 584,780 service hours were donated by bank associates to community causes
- 110.6 million total dollars donated to community groups:
 - \$108,382,851 donated by banks to community causes
 - \$1,327,313 donated by banks to fund scholarships
 - \$915,402 donated by banks through in-kind contributions to community causes
